



## 2.6 CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT POLICY

### 1 Introduction

- 1.1 This document provides guidance on Yeovil and Sherborne Hockey Club's clothing and equipment policy. It is the initial source of information for members, and parents, on purchasing clothing and equipment.

### 2 General Policy

- 2.1 The Club's policy is aimed at ensuring that participants gain the greatest possible enjoyment from playing hockey by minimising costs and maximising safety.
- 2.2 To maintain security of supply and provide members with options for purchasing clothing and equipment, wherever possible unbranded clothing is specified: Other than one item of mandated clothing - the current Club playing shirt - no particular manufacturer's clothing is proscribed.
- 2.3 The Club will arrange for a range of suitable clothing to be made available for purchase either at sports outlets in Yeovil and/or Sherborne, or online via the club website. Information on where and how to purchase clothing, and equipment, will be provided on the Club's website.
- 2.4 To ensure uniformity it is the Club's policy not to carry sponsorship on any playing or other clothing.
- 2.5 Full specification of club colours, badges and logos/lettering can be found in document **YSHC 2.5 Style Guide**.

### 3 Advice

- 3.1 Clarification on this policy should be sought from the Club Chairman or the Director of Hockey.
- 3.2 Advice and guidance on clothing and equipment, and particularly protective equipment, may be sought from the Director of Hockey and Coaches.

### 4 Safety Equipment

- 4.1 Junior Members will not be allowed to participate in any hockey activity without wearing the items of protective equipment indicated below.
- 4.2 The wearing of the following functional, correct fitting protective equipment is recommended/mandatory:
- 4.2.1 Shin Guards – mandatory for Juniors.
  - 4.2.2 Mouth Guards – mandatory for Juniors.
  - 4.2.3 Glove(s)

## **5 Playing Clothing.**

5.1 Playing members are expected provide their own playing kit following the guidelines below. Examples of playing clothing are illustrated in Annex A.

5.1.1 **Playing Shirts.** The Club's policy is to review the design and manufacture of the playing shirt every 5 years (or more).

5.1.1.1 **Colour:** SKY BLUE.

5.1.1.2 To ensure uniformity the Club will specify the design and manufacturer of a club playing shirt branded with the club badge, and arrange for it to be made available for purchase through the club website or in a local retail outlet.

5.1.1.3 The purchase by members (playing in representative matches) of the specified playing shirt is mandatory.

5.1.2 **Playing Men's/Boy's Shorts:**

5.1.2.1 **Colour:** WHITE.

5.1.3 **Playing Ladies/Girl's Skorts:**

5.1.3.1 **Colour:** BURGUNDY or MAROON.

5.1.4 **Playing Socks:**

5.1.4.1 **Colour:** SKY BLUE.

5.1.5 **Goalkeeper Smocks:**

5.1.5.1 **Colour:** ORANGE.

5.1.6 **Baselayers.** The colour of any baselayer must match the outerlayer:

5.1.6.1 Under playing shirt the baselayer colour must be SKY BLUE if the baselayer has long sleeves.

5.1.6.2 Under men's/boy's shorts the baselayer colour must be WHITE.

5.1.6.3 Under ladies/girl's skorts the baselayer colour must be BURGUNDY OR MAROON.

5.2 **Alternate Playing Clothing.** In cases of a colour clash with an opposition team when playing away matches a change of shirt and socks is required; no change of shorts or skorts is required.

5.2.1 **Alternate Playing Shirts:**

5.2.1.1 **Colour:** Burgundy with Orange Inserts.

5.2.1.2 Individuals WILL NOT be required to purchase alternate shirts which will be supplied by the Club in team sets (men's, ladies, juniors).

5.2.2 **Alternate Playing Socks:**

5.2.2.1 **Colour:** White.

5.2.2.2 Individuals WILL be expected to provide white socks.

**6 Other clothing.**

6.1 Other clothing such as casual shirts, training shirts/tops and tracksuits should follow the colours specified below:

6.1.1 **Polo shirts:** Sky Blue, or Navy Blue with or without Sky Blue inserts.

6.1.2 **Training shirts:** Sky Blue, or Navy Blue with or without Sky Blue inserts.

6.1.3 **Training tops:** Navy Blue, with or without Sky Blue inserts, or Slate Blue.

6.1.4 **Gilets:** Navy blue.

6.1.5 **Jackets:** Navy Blue, with or without Sky Blue inserts

6.1.6 **Coats/Waterproof jackets:** Navy Blue.

6.1.7 **Training trousers/Waterproof trousers:** Navy Blue.

6.2 The Club will arrange for a range of such clothing, branded with the club badge, to be made available for purchase online via the club website, or in a local retail outlet at reasonable prices.

6.3 To present a uniform image members are encouraged to consider purchasing club branded clothing wherever possible.

6.4 Examples of other clothing are illustrated in Annex B.
