Specific to Yeovil & Sherborne:

- We want to create highly skilled, creative, independent, resilient players who make their own decisions and self-organise both on and off the pitch.
 - Do not remote control!
 - Be specific and realistic in feedback.
 - Failure is an essential part of the learning process.
- The result of a fixture is one of the only things that we cannot control; focus on our performance, improvement, or priorities for development.
- Not every player will be a performance player, but they should all be life-long participants.
- What you do and say can have a huge impact on a young persons' life.

Practise: Designing a Drill

- Game-realistic.
- Decision-rich.
- Position- or Pitch-specific.
- Opportunities for creativity in technique or tactics.
- Wherever possible, feedback is player-led or intrinsic to the drill.
- Ask open questions: Never yes/no, allow time for them to give the answer.
